SAN ANTONIO (December 11, 2013) – The South Texas Energy and Economic Roundtable (STEER), announced today that HOLT CAT, Halliburton, Caesar Kleberg Wildlife Research Institute at Texas A&M University – Kingsville, Dynamic Industries, Inc., Energy Waste, and Primera Energy as the recipients of the inaugural 2013 Eagle Ford Excellence Awards. The awards honor leading companies and organizations working in or with the oil and gas industry by recognizing diligent efforts in the areas of community and social investment, environmental stewardship, and safety performance within the Eagle Ford Shale region.

"STEER stands by its commitment to protect and preserve the health of the environment, communities and individuals in our South Texas communities. The Eagle Ford Excellence Award recipients set the standard for good corporate citizenship and STEER is honored to provide a forum to recognize companies that make this a priority," says Omar Garcia, president of STEER.

"The economic transformation taking place in the Eagle Ford Shale is remarkable. South Texas transitioned from being one of the poorest areas in Texas to a thriving region, but it is also important to preserve and protect the rapidly growing counties along the shale and their residents during this time of swift change. The Eagle Ford Excellence Awards allow for recognition of such efforts," says Henry Cisneros, keynote speaker at the luncheon.

This inaugural event provides both oil and gas companies and their contractors an opportunity to be acknowledged for their efforts in preserving the environment, contributing to the communities in which they work, and promoting safety in and around the workplace. The awards will be given to

applicants that exemplify innovation, take initiative and benefit the greater South Texas region.

"When selecting judges for the Eagle Ford Excellence Awards, getting the perspective of professionals outside of the oil and gas industry was important to STEER and its members. We felt it was necessary to truly be able to judge the efforts and results of companies and organizations working in the region," says Garcia. Judges for the 2013 Eagle Ford Excellence Awards include representatives from the Alamo Area Council of Governments (AACOG), CPS Energy and the University of Texas at San Antonio (UTSA).
